AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS TO FUND EARLY VOTING SITES IN THE 2008 PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTIONS.

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the Election Fund under G.S. 163-82.28 to the State Board of Elections the sum of seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of one million seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,750,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to fund additional one-stop absentee voting (early voting) sites for the primary and general elections in 2008.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
