A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS
2 TO FUND EARLY VOTING SITES IN THE 2008 PRIMARY AND GENERAL
3 ELECTIONS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the Election Fund under
7 G.S. 163-82.28 to the State Board of Elections the sum of seven hundred fifty thousand
8 dollars (\$750,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of one million seven
9 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,750,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to fund
10 additional one-stop absentee voting (early voting) sites for the primary and general
11 elections in 2008.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
