The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 1-15 is amended by adding a new subsection t	o read:
"(d) A cause of action for breach of contract or breach of warran	ty, whether
express or implied, arising out of the performance of a construction project	to improve
real property shall be deemed to accrue at the time of the occurrence of the	ne breach or
upon substantial completion of the construction, whichever is later. As	used in this
subsection, 'substantial completion' has the same meaning as in G.S. 1-50."	
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law, applie	es to actions
filed on or after that date, and does not revive claims previously barred under	r G.S. 1-15.

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
