4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Article 47 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by
6	adding a new section to read:
7	"§ 14-360.1. Immunity for veterinarian reporting animal cruelty.
8	Any veterinarian licensed in this State who has reasonable cause to believe that an
9	animal has been the subject of animal cruelty in violation of G.S. 14-360 and who
10	makes a report of animal cruelty, or who participates in any investigation or testifies in
11	any judicial proceeding that arises from a report of animal cruelty, shall be immune
12	from civil liability, criminal liability, and liability from professional disciplinary action
13	and shall not be in breach of any veterinarian-patient confidentiality, unless the
14	veterinarian acted in bad faith or with a malicious purpose. It shall be a rebuttable
15	presumption that the veterinarian acted in good faith. A failure by a veterinarian to
16	make a report of animal cruelty shall not constitute grounds for disciplinary action
17	under G.S. 90-187.8."
18	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective October 1, 2007.
