2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE COLLEGE OF VETERINARY
3	MEDICINE CLINICAL TEACHING AND RESEARCH FUND.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
6	Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of five hundred thousand
7	dollars (\$500,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred thousand
8	dollars (\$500,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to be allocated to North Carolina State
9	University for the College of Veterinary Medicine Clinical Teaching and Research
10	Fund. These funds shall be used as follows:
11	(1) To allow advanced diagnostic and treatment options for animals of all
12	species presented to the College of Veterinary Medicine Teaching
13	Hospitals and Services, where either the (i) owner financing of such
14	options are limited, (ii) significant instructional value exists, or (iii) the
15	conduct of such diagnostic and treatment options has the potential of
16	adding significantly to core knowledge in the relevant clinical area.
17	(2) To allow establishment and support of a Veterinary Clinical Trials
18	Program, aimed at generating new, clinically relevant knowledge
19	across multiple species by assessment of the efficacy of novel
20	diagnostics, therapeutics, and treatment modalities in a broad
21	population of the relevant species.
22	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
