| 5  | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  |
| 6  | <b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 135-4(g) reads as rewritten:                                       |
| 7  | "(g) Teachers and other State employees who served in the armed forces of the             |
| 8  | United States uniformed services as defined in the Uniformed Services Employment          |
| 9  | and Reemployment Rights Act of 1994, 38 U.S.C. § 4303, and who, after being               |
| 10 | honorably discharged, returned to the service of the State within a period of two years   |
| 11 | from date of discharge shall be credited with prior service for such period of service in |
| 12 | the armed forces of the United States; and the salaries or compensations paid to such     |
| 13 | employees immediately before entering the armed forces shall be deemed to be the          |
| 14 | actual compensation rates of such teachers and State employees during said period of      |
| 15 | service. uniformed services for the maximum period that they are entitled to              |
| 16 | reemployment under the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights              |
| 17 | Act of 1994, 38 U.S.C. § 4301, et seq., or other federal law, and the salary or           |
| 18 | compensation of such a teacher or State employee during that period of service is         |
| 19 | deemed to be that salary or compensation the employee would have received but for the     |
| 20 | period of service had the employee remained continuously employed, if the                 |
| 21 | determination of that salary or compensation is reasonably certain. If the determination  |
| 22 | of the salary or compensation is not reasonably certain, then it is deemed to be that     |
| 23 | employee's average rate of compensation during the 12-month period immediately            |
| 24 | preceding the period of service."   |
| 25 | <b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.                                |
