16	duty to do so b	by first-class mail sent to the manufacturer's last known address. The

20	<u>(1)</u>	The nonparticipating manufacturer has not previously established and
21		funded a qualified escrow fund in North Carolina.
22	<u>(2)</u>	The nonparticipating manufacturer has not made any escrow deposits
23		for more than one year.
24	<u>(3)</u>	The nonparticipating manufacturer has failed to make a timely and
25		complete escrow deposit in any prior calendar year.
26	<u>(4)</u>	The nonparticipating manufacturer has failed to pay any judgment,
27		including any civil penalty.
28	<u>(5)</u>	The nonparticipating manufacturer sells more than 1,000,000
29		<u>cigarettes during a calendar quarter.</u>

1	(6) The Attorney General has reasonable cause to believe that the
2	nonparticipating manufacturer may not make its full required escrow
3	deposit by April 15 of the year following the year in which the
4	cigarette sales are made."
