G.S. 20-30(5) reads as rewritten: 5) To use a false or fictitious name or give a false or fictitious address in any application for a driver's license or learner's permit, or any renewa or duplicate thereof, or knowingly to make a false statement of knowingly conceal a material fact or otherwise commit a fraud in any such application, or for any person to procure, or knowingly permit of allow another to commit any of the foregoing acts. Any license of learner's permit procured as aforesaid shall be void from the issuance thereof, and any moneys paid therefor shall be forfeited to the State Any person violating the provisions of this subdivision shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. I felony."
