3	HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL
4	DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES, TO PROVIDE FOR A
5	PILOT PROJECT TO ASSESS THE FEASIBILITY OF ENACTING MENTAL
6	HEALTH SERVICES TRANSFORMATION TO A COMPREHENSIVE BEST
7	PRACTICE SERVICE IN RURAL COMMUNITIES.
8	Whereas, northeastern North Carolina is the State's most economically
9	distressed region; and
10	Whereas, the Albemarle Region covers 3,339 square miles, has only 58
11	persons per square mile, and includes many remote communities that need immediate
12	attention to successfully participate in the State's Mental Health Reform efforts; and
13	Whereas, the State is faced with a historical funding base that is not equitably
14	distributed leaving some counties with greater need that is relatively underfunded due to
15	low population density and indigent communities status; and
16	Whereas, mental health, developmental disabilities, and substance abuse
17	services cannot be equitably applied statewide as long as the funding allocation process
18	continues and the rural communities in northeastern North Carolina do not have the
19	resources to address issues such as best practice community services; and
20	Whereas, rural low-wealth counties tend to over-utilize State institutions for
21	mental health, developmental disability, and substance abuse services; and
22	Whereas, in order to appropriately plan for improvement in the State's Mental
23	Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services System, decisions
24	must be made on what can reasonably be funded and managed over the next five years;

26	Whereas, the State must establish a priority for the System changes it desires,
27	starting first with those things that save resources and promote good care; and

1 Whereas, affordable, available, and sustainable MH/DD/SA services remains 2 a challenge for all counties in North Carolina, especially remote and rural low-wealth 3 communities; and

Whereas, because of the investment required and profitability being based on population and demand, a determination must be made whether an alternative business structure for the management and delivery of services, versus the present governmental structure, provides the best solution for all citizens of this State; Now, therefore,

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 SECTION 1.(a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 10 Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental 11 Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services (MH/DD/SA), the sum of one million four 12 hundred ninety-two thousand dollars (\$1,492,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year, and the 13 sum of one million nine hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$1,930,000) for the 2008-2009 14 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated as nonunit cost reimbursement funds for the 15 Albemarle Local Management Entity (LME) to design and implement the business structure for a five-year pilot program. The purposes of the pilot program are to assess 16 17 the affordability and sustainability of an alternative business model for the management 18 and delivery of best practice mental health, developmental disabilities, and substance 19 abuse services in remote, rural, low-wealth communities. The business model shall 20 address issues of initial investment and profitability in attracting providers on a 21 sustained basis.

SECTION 1.(b) The Albemarle LME may enter into agreements with the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, regarding integration of funding resources as it may relate to decreasing categorical restrictions or negotiating capitation formulas, incentives, and penalties, State reporting requirements, and other State law and policies that may impede the full realization of a cost effective business model for the growth and delivery of MH/DD/SA services in the pilot areas.

SECTION 2.(a) Funds appropriated in this act that are unexpended and unencumbered at the end of each fiscal year shall not revert to the General Fund but shall remain with the Department of Health and Human Services to be used for the purposes of this act.

33 **SECTION 2.(b)** The Department of Health and Human Services, Division 34 of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, shall 35 report annually to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Mental Health, 36 Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services (Oversight Committee) on 37 the implementation and evaluation of the progress of the pilot program. The 38 Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental 39 Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, shall make its final report to the Oversight 40 Committee on or before March 1, 2013.

41 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007, and expires July 1, 42 2012.
