AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ENSURE ADEQUATE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT PEMBROKE.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated as a grant-in-aid to the Pembroke Rural Volunteer Fire Department, Inc., and used to purchase a 100-foot aerial fire truck and equipment to ensure adequate fire protection services to the University of North Carolina at Pembroke.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
