1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND
3	ITS CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS SHALL NOT COUNT OUT-OF-STATE
4	STUDENTS AS IN-STATE STUDENTS FOR ANY CALCULATION OF THE
5	UNIVERSITY SYSTEM'S STUDENT POPULATION.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. Part 5 of Article 3 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is
8	amended by adding a new section to read:
9	" <u>§ 116-43.15. Calculation of in-State and out-of-state students.</u>
10	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, The University of North Carolina and
11	its constituent institutions shall not count any out-of-state student as an in-State student
12	for any calculation regarding the student population of The University System."
13	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to the
14	2007-2008 academic year and each subsequent academic year.
