A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT DIRECTING THE AUDITOR TO STUDY THE COSTS RELATING TO  
THE ADMINISTRATION OF CAPITAL PUNISHMENT AND THE SAVINGS  
FROM REPEAL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** The State Auditor shall assess the costs to the State associated with the administration of the capital punishment statute and the savings that could be achieved if the statute were to be repealed and shall report to the General Assembly on this issue by March 1, 2008.

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
