1 AN ACT DIRECTING THE AUDITOR TO STUDY THE COSTS RELATING TO
2 THE ADMINISTRATION OF CAPITAL PUNISHMENT AND THE SAVINGS
3 FROM REPEAL.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** The State Auditor shall assess the costs to the State associated
7 with the administration of the capital punishment statute and the savings that could be
8 achieved if the statute were to be repealed and shall report to the General Assembly on
9 this issue by March 1, 2008.

10 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
