6 **SECTION 1.** The State Auditor shall assess the costs to the State associated 7 with the administration of the capital punishment statute and the savings that could be 8 achieved if the statute were to be repealed and shall report to the General Assembly on 9 this issue by March 1, 2008.

10 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
