A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ADD GASOLINE-POWERED GOLF CARTS TO THOSE GOLF
CARTS THAT MAY BE REGULATED IN THE TOWNS OF
ELIZABETHTOWN, ROSE HILL, AND BLADENBORO.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of S.L. 2005-11 reads as rewritten:

"**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 20-50 and G.S. 20-54, a town may, by ordinance, regulate the operation of gasoline-powered or electric golf carts on any public street or road within the town.

By ordinance, a town may require the registration of golf carts, charge a fee for the registration, specify the persons authorized to operate golf carts, and specify the required equipment, load limits, and the hours and methods of operation of golf carts."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
