SESSION LAW 2007-522 HOUSE BILL 206

AN ACT TO DISTINGUISH BETWEEN SPECIAL PLATES ISSUED TO BRONZE STAR RECIPIENTS FOR MERITORIOUS SERVICE OR FOR VALOR IN COMBAT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

"(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration plates:

Bronze Star Combat Recipient. – Issuable to a recipient of the Bronze
Star Medal for valor in combat. The plate shall bear the emblem of the
Bronze Star with a "Combat V" emblem and the words "Bronze Star."
To be eligible for this plate, the applicant must provide documentation that the medal was issued for valor in combat.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law. In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 2nd day of August, 2007.
