2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
3	HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL
4	DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES, FOR EARLY
5	INTERVENTION PROGRAMS.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
8	Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental
9	Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000)
10	for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated as follows:
11	(1) \$1,250,000 for the development of model programs of early
12	intervention across the State; and
13	(2) \$750,000 to the Autism Society of North Carolina for training and
14	collaboration with model programs and community agencies to
15	increase availability of early intervention for autism.
16	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
