A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXEMPT BUSES FROM SAFETY INSPECTIONS REQUIRED UNDER MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS IF THEY ARE TITLED TO A LOCAL EDUCATION AGENCY AND SUBJECT TO SCHOOL BUS INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE TRANSPORTATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-183.2(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) Safety Inspection ~~Exception~~Exceptions. – ~~Historic vehicles, as defined in G.S. 20-79.4(b)(55)~~The following vehicles shall not be subject to a safety inspection pursuant to this ~~Article~~Article:

(1) Historic vehicles, as defined in G.S. 20-79.4(b)(55).

(2) Buses titled to a local education agency and subject to the school bus inspection requirements specified by the State Board of Education and G.S. 115C-248(a)."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
