A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO INCREASE FUNDING FOR ACADEMICALLY OR  
2 INTELLECTUALLY GIFTED CHILDREN.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
6 Department of Public Instruction the sum of three million five hundred eighteen  
7 thousand three hundred eighty-three dollars (\$3,518,383) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year  
8 to increase funding for academically or intellectually gifted students. The State Board of  
9 Education shall allocate funds for academically or intellectually gifted children on the  
10 basis of one thousand one hundred forty-two dollars and fifty-eight cents (\$1,142.58)  
11 per child. Each local school administrative unit shall receive funds for a maximum of  
12 four percent (4%) of its 2008-2009 allocated average daily membership, regardless of  
13 the number of children identified as academically or intellectually gifted in the unit.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
