10	<u>(6)</u>	A taxpayer who is an eligible emergency services worker may deduct
11	<u>1</u>	from taxable income the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) if the
12	1	taxpayer has qualified as an eligible emergency services worker for
13]	less than three years and the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) if
14	1	the taxpayer has qualified as an eligible emergency services worker for
15	<u>1</u>	three or more years. In the case of a married couple filing a joint
