A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	AN ACT TO AMEND CERTAIN ENVIRONMENTAL AND NATURAL
3	RESOURCES LAWS TO PROVIDE THAT PRIVATE DRINKING WATER
4	WELLS ARE TO BE TESTED FOR CERTAIN ADDITIONAL PARAMETERS,
5	AS RECOMMENDED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 87-97(h) reads as rewritten:
8	"(h) Drinking Water Testing Within 30 days after it issues a certificate of
9	completion for a newly constructed private drinking water well, the local health
10	department shall test the water obtained from the well or ensure that the water obtained
11	from the well has been sampled and tested by a certified laboratory in accordance with
12	rules adopted by the Commission for Public Health. The water shall be tested for the
13	following parameters: arsenic, barium, cadmium, chromium, copper, fluoride, lead,
14	iron, magnesium, manganese, mercury, nitrates, nitrites, selenium, silver, sodium, zinc,
15	pH, and bacterial indicators, methyl tert-butyl ether, ethylene dibromide,
16	1,2-dichloroethane, 1,2-dichloropropane, isopropyl ether, benzene, toluene,
17	ethylbenzene, xylenes, trichloroethylene, and tetrachloroethylene."
18	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective 1 July 2008.

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
