4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. G.S. 115D-5.1 reads as rewritten:  
6 "§ 115D-5.1. Workforce Development Programs.

7 ...  
8 (c) The State Board of Community Colleges shall report to the Joint Legislative  
9 Education Oversight Committee on September 1 of each year on expenditures for the  
10 ~~New and Expanding Industry Training Program~~ Customized Training Programs each  
11 fiscal year. The report shall include, for each company or individual that receives funds  
12 for the ~~New and Expanding Industry Training Program~~ Customized Training Programs:

- 13 (1) The total amount of funds received by the company or individual;  
14 (2) The amount of funds per trainee received by the company or  
15 individual;  
16 (3) The amount of funds received per trainee by the community college  
17 training the trainee;  
18 (4) The number of trainees trained by company and by community  
19 college; and  
20 (5) The number of years the companies or individuals have been funded.

21 (d) Funds available to the ~~New and Expanding Industry Training Program~~ for  
22 Customized Training Programs shall not revert at the end of a fiscal year but shall  
23 remain available until expended.

24 (e) ~~There is created within the North Carolina Community College System the~~  
25 ~~Customized Industry Training (CIT) Program. The CIT Program shall offer programs~~  
26 ~~and training services as new options for assisting existing business and industry to~~

1 remain productive, profitable, and within the State. Before a business or industry  
2 qualifies to receive assistance under the CIT Program, the President of the North  
3 Carolina Community College System shall determine that:

- 4 (1) The business is making an appreciable capital investment;
- 5 (2) The business is deploying new technology; and
- 6 (3) The skills of the workers will be enhanced by the assistance.

7 (e) Customized Training Programs shall include programs that:

- 8 (1) Create new jobs and promote job growth,
- 9 (2) Enhance productivity, and
- 10 (3) Enhance company technology and investment in plant.

11 (f) ~~The State Board shall report on an annual basis to the Joint Legislative~~  
12 ~~Education Oversight Committee on:~~

- 13 (1) ~~The total amount of funds received by a company under the CIT~~  
14 ~~Program;~~
- 15 (2) ~~The amount of funds per trainee received by that company;~~
- 16 (3) ~~The amount of funds received per trainee by the community college~~  
17 ~~delivering the training;~~
- 18 (4) ~~The number of trainees trained by the company and community~~  
19 ~~college; and~~
- 20 (5) ~~The number of years that company has been funded.~~

21 (f) Of the funds appropriated for Customized Training Programs, the State Board  
22 of Community Colleges may allocate up to seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000)  
23 per year for the support of regional instructional personnel in order to establish training  
24 infrastructure to deliver customized training services to business and industry.
