2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO PRODUCE 3 A SPECIAL PLATE FOR GRADUATES OF THE UNITED STATES SERVICE 4 ACADEMIES, WHICH INCLUDE THE UNITED STATES AIR FORCE 5 ACADEMY, THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD ACADEMY, THE 6 UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY, AND THE UNITED STATES 7 NAVAL ACADEMY.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-63(b) reads as rewritten:

10 Every license plate shall have displayed upon it the registration number "(b) 11 assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of the State of North Carolina, 12 which may be abbreviated, and the year number for which it is issued or the date of 13 expiration. A plate issued for a commercial vehicle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.2(1), and 14 weighing 26,001 pounds or more, must bear the word "commercial," unless the plate is 15 a special registration plate authorized in G.S. 20-79.4 or the commercial vehicle is a trailer or is licensed for 6,000 pounds or less. The plate issued for vehicles licensed for 16 17 7,000 pounds through 26,000 pounds must bear the word "weighted".

Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a registration plate issued by the 18 19 Division for a private passenger vehicle or for a private hauler vehicle licensed for 6,000 pounds or less shall be a "First in Flight" plate. A "First in Flight" plate shall have 20 the words "First in Flight" printed at the top of the plate above all other letters and 21 22 numerals. The background of the plate shall depict the Wright Brothers biplane flying 23 over Kitty Hawk Beach, with the plane flying slightly upward and to the right. The following special registration plates do not have to be a "First in Flight" plate. The 24 25 design of the plates that are not "First in Flight" plates must be approved by the Division 26 and the State Highway Patrol for clarity and ease of identification.
