HOUSE BILL 364

Short Title: Funds for NC Literacy Connection Program. (Public) Sponsors: Representatives Yongue, Coleman, Ross, Weiss (Primary Sponsors); Adams, Alexander, Faison, Farmer-Butterfield, Glazier, Harrison, Luebke, Parmon, Pierce, Wainwright, and Wray. Referred to: Appropriations. February 26, 2007 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NC LITERACY CONNECTION PROGRAM. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to provide funding for the NC Literacy Connection Program. The NC Literacy Connection Program shall be administered by Project Enlightenment in Wake County. The Program shall: (1)Develop a sustainable, statewide network of preschool early literacy leaders: (2)Provide research-based training and guided-model classroom observation to preschool early literacy leaders; Support administrators in coaching preschool teachers on literacy (3) instruction strategies; (4) Work with the More at Four program to provide training and technical support to all 100 counties;

(5) Track and monitor, in cooperation with participants in the 100 counties, the effects of the Program; and

(6) Report to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee on the
effects of the Program by July 1, 2008, and July 1, 2009.

24 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
