HOUSE BILL 382

Short Title: Hemby Bridge Elections. (Local)

Sponsors: Representative Blackwood.

Referred to: Local Government II, if favorable, Election Law and Campaign Finance Reform.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ELECTIONS IN THE TOWN OF HEMBY BRIDGE
SHALL BE DETERMINED BY PLURALITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 4.1 of the Charter of Hemby Bridge, being S.L.
1998-143, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 4.1. **Conduct of Town Elections.** Town officers shall be elected on a
nonpartisan ~~election and runoff~~ plurality basis and results determined as provided in
G.S. ~~163-293, 163-292.~~"

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
