A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE CIVIL ACTIONS OF ALIENATION OF AFFECTION
AND CRIMINAL CONVERSATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Chapter 52 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
new section to read:

"§ 52-13. Abolition of alienation of affection cause of action.

The common-law cause of action for alienation of affection of a spouse is
abolished."

SECTION 2. Chapter 52 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
new section to read:

"§ 52-14. Abolition of criminal conversation cause of action.

The common-law cause of action for criminal conversation is abolished."

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law. This act does not
affect cases pending when the act becomes law.
