A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PERMIT THE MADISON COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS TO  
MOVE A PRECINCT BOUNDARY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S.163-132.3, the Madison County Board of Elections may revise the boundary of the precincts of Marshall North and Mars Hill by moving from Mars Hill Precinct to Marshall North Precinct the area bounded by the existing Marshall North-Mars Hill Precinct line, the Buncombe-Madison County line, Eller Branch, Ivy Creek, Stillhouse Branch, and an extended straight line from the northern terminus of Stillhouse Branch to the intersection of Wind Swept Bridge Road and Windswept Ridge Road, and consisting of the following 2000 Census Blocks:

(1) All of Blocks 3000, 3001, 3002, and 3003 of Tract 105.

(2) All of Block 1057 of Tract 105 except for the portion east of Stillhouse Branch and the extended straight line from the northern terminus of Stillhouse Branch to the intersection of Wind Swept Bridge Road and Windswept Ridge Road.

(3) All of Blocks 4043, 4048, 4049, 4050, 4051, and 4052 of Tract 106.

(4) The portion of Block 4044 of Tract 106 west of Eller Branch.

**SECTION 2.** The precincts, tracts, block groups, and blocks in Section 2 of this act shall be as shown on the General Assembly's redistricting database as of January 1, 2007.

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
