There is appropriated from the General Fund to Manchester 9 10 CDC, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to develop cultural and recreational activities in the Manchester 11 12 Township of Cumberland County. **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Hollywood 13 14 Heights Community Club, Incorporated, a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for community association 15 16 improvements. 17 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Seventy First Township Civic Improvement Association, Incorporated, a nonprofit organization, 18 the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to provide civic, 19 20 cultural, and senior citizen activities. 21 **SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Tiffany Pines 22 Community Outreach Center, a nonprofit organization, the sum of five thousand dollars 23 (\$5,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for use in providing bicycles and computers to 24 disadvantaged youth in the City of Fayetteville and surrounding areas. The operator of 25 this Center is known as the "Bicycle Man." 26 **SECTION 5.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Sandhills 27 Family Heritage Association, a nonprofit organization, the sum of fifteen thousand
