A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO ASSIST WITH PLANNING COSTS FOR THE RENOVATION OF CARMICHAEL HALL AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT ASHEVILLE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of nine hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$930,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be allocated to the University of North Carolina at Asheville to assist with the planning costs for the renovation of Carmichael Hall, a 1966 academic building that has had only maintenance repairs since construction.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
