6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 135-1(20) reads as rewritten:
8	"(20) "Retirement" means the termination of employment and the complete
9	separation from active service with no intent or agreement, express or
10	implied, to return to service. A retirement allowance under the
11	provisions of this Chapter may only be granted upon retirement of a
12	member. In order for a member's retirement to become effective in any
13	month, the member must render no service, including part-time,
14	temporary, substitute, or contractor service, at any time during the six
15	three months immediately following the effective date of retirement."
16	SECTION 2. G.S. 135-3(8)c. reads as rewritten:
17	"c. Should a beneficiary who retired on an early or service
18	retirement allowance under this Chapter be reemployed, or
19	otherwise engaged to perform services, by an employer
20	participating in the Retirement System on a part-time,
21	temporary, interim, or on a fee-for-service basis, whether
22	contractual or otherwise, and if such beneficiary earns an
23	amount during the 12-month period immediately following the
24	effective date of retirement or in any calendar year which
25	exceeds fifty percent (50%) of the reported compensation,
26	excluding terminal payments, during the 12 months of service
27	preceding the effective date of retirement, or twenty thousand

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	dollars (\$20,000), whichever is greater, as hereinafter indexed,		
	then the retirement allowance shall be suspended as of the first		
	day of the month following the month in which the		
	reemployment earnings exceed the amount above, for the		
	balance of the calendar year. The retirement allowance of the		
	beneficiary shall be reinstated as of January 1 of each year		
	following suspension. The amount that may be earned before		
	suspension shall be increased on January 1 of each year by the		
	ratio of the Consumer Price Index to the Index one year earlier,		
	calculated to the nearest tenth of a percent $(1/10 \text{ of } 1\%)$.		
	The computation of postretirement earnings of a beneficiary		
	under this sub-subdivision, G.S. 135-3(8)c., who has been		
	retired at least six three months and has not been employed in		
	any capacity with a public school for at least six three months		
	immediately preceding the effective date of reemployment,		
	shall not include earnings while the beneficiary is employed to		
	teach in a permanent full-time or part-time capacity that		
	exceeds fifty percent (50%) of the applicable workweek in a		
	public school. The Department of Public Instruction shall		
	certify to the Retirement System that a beneficiary is employed		
	to teach by a local school administrative unit under the		
	provisions of this sub-subdivision and as a retired teacher as the		
	term is defined under the provisions of G.S. 115C-325(a)(5a).		
	Beneficiaries employed under this sub-subdivision are not		
	entitled to any benefits otherwise provided under this Chapter		
	as a result of this period of employment."
