A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR DIVISION TEACCH AT THE  
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of  
Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of three hundred sixty-eight  
thousand two hundred dollars (\$368,200) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be used by  
Division TEACCH in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of North Carolina  
at Chapel Hill. These funds shall be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$175,902 to expand the TEACCHing at Home pilot program to the  
Asheville and Wilmington areas. The current program serves Orange  
County and provides home-based early intervention services to autistic  
preschoolers from 18 months to three years of age.
- (2) \$142,298 to complete the salary adjustments for therapists working  
with the TEACCH program.
- (3) \$50,000 to support research and program development for the  
TEACCH Autism Program.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
