2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE
3 UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA
4 RESEARCH CAMPUS AT KANNAPOLIS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
7 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of twelve million five hundred
8 eighty-one thousand one hundred twenty-one dollars (\$12,581,121) in recurring funds
9 and thirteen million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$13,700,000) in nonrecurring
10 funds for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to enable the University to lease space, plan, and
11 operate programs at the North Carolina Research Campus at Kannapolis. The Director
12 of the Office of State Budget and Management shall release the funds appropriated by
13 this section in three increments pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding dated
14 November 30, 2006.

15 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
16 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of twenty million two hundred
17 twenty-two thousand five hundred sixty-two dollars (\$20,222,562) in recurring funds
18 and two million one hundred thousand dollars (\$2,100,000) in nonrecurring funds for
19 the 2008-2009 fiscal year to enable the University to lease space, plan, and operate
20 programs at the North Carolina Research Campus at Kannapolis. The Director of the
21 Budget shall release the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) in nonrecurring funds
22 appropriated by this section only when the President of The University of North
23 Carolina certifies to the Director that the Core Laboratory Facility is complete and that
24 all of The University of North Carolina space is substantially fully operational.

25 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
