SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of eight million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$8,700,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be allocated to the University of North Carolina at Asheville to fund a comprehensive renovation of Rhoades Hall and Tower which are academic buildings on campus. The two buildings are without air-conditioning, have mechanical systems that are in poor condition, and use excessive energy.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
