1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR DIVISION TEACCH AT THE
3	UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
6	Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of three hundred sixty-eight
7	thousand two hundred dollars (\$368,200) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be used by
8	Division TEACCH in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of North Carolina
9	at Chapel Hill. These funds shall be allocated as follows:
10	(1) \$175,902 to expand the TEACCHing at Home pilot program to the
11	Asheville and Wilmington areas. The current program serves Orange
12	County and provides home-based early intervention services to autistic
13	preschoolers from 18 months to three years of age.
14	(2) \$142,298 to complete the salary adjustments for therapists working
15	with the TEACCH program.
16	(3) \$50,000 to support research and program development for the
17	TEACCH Autism Program.
18	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
