A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT DIRECTING THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO ADOPT POLICY REQUIRING TEACHERS TO TAKE CREDITS IN THEIR ACADEMY SUBJECT AREA AS PART OF THE LICENSURE RENEWAL PROCESS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. The State Board of Education shall adopt a policy the requires:	IC
requires: (1) Teachers of grades kindergarten through eight to take three renew credits in their academic subject areas, including strategies to teach those subjects, during each five-year license renewal cycle and (2) Teachers in grades nine through twelve to take three credits in the academic subject areas, including strategies to teach those subject during each five-year license renewal cycle.	ch eir
For teachers who are in the fourth or fifth year of their current five-year license renew cycle, this policy shall apply beginning with the first year of their next five-year licen renewal cycle. The State Board may provide for exceptions to this policy for teacher seeking certification or renewal of certification by the National Board for Profession Teaching Standards.	se
