AN ACT TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN
SERVICES TO STUDY ISSUES RELATING TO HEARING LOSS IN OLDER
ADULTS IN NORTH CAROLINA AS RECOMMENDED BY THE STUDY
COMMISSION ON AGING.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1.(a) The Department of Health and Human Services, Division of
Services for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, shall study the impact of hearing loss on
North Carolina's older adult population. The study shall examine the following:
(1) The availability of and access to qualified professionals for diagnosis
and treatment.
(2) The availability of and access to hearing aid purchase assistance
programs for low-income individuals.
(3) Developing an inventory of adaptive technology options available to
assist older adults with hearing loss.
(4) Resources and programs available in other states.
SECTION 1.(b) In response to the study authorized in this section, the
Department of Health and Human Services shall present findings and recommendations
to the Study Commission on Aging on or before November 1, 2009.
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
