2 AN ACT DIRECTING THE GENERAL STATUTES COMMISSION TO STUDY
3 THE UNIFORM EMERGENCY VOLUNTEER HEALTH PRACTITIONERS ACT
4 AND TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AS
5 RECOMMENDED BY THE SUBCOMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH AND
6 BIOTERRORISM OF THE JOINT SELECT COMMITTEE ON EMERGENCY
7 PREPAREDNESS AND DISASTER MANAGEMENT RECOVERY.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 **SECTION 1.** The General Statutes Commission is directed to study the
10 Uniform Emergency Volunteer Health Practitioners Act in consultation with interested
11 parties and to report to the 2009 General Assembly on the Commission's
12 recommendations and legislative proposals.

13 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
