(CAREGIVER 3 ON EMPTY) ALTERNATIVES TO RUNNING WHICH PROVIDES CONSUMER-DIRECTED RESPITE CARE AND COMPREHENSIVE SUPPORT 4 5 TO DEMENTIA CAREGIVERS WITH A GOAL OF INCREASING RESPITE 6 AND SUPPORT SERVICES TO LOW-INCOME RURAL AND MINORITY 7 CAREGIVERS. AS RECOMMENDED BY THE NORTH CAROLINA STUDY 8 COMMISSION ON AGING. 9 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 10 SECTION 1. Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Aging and Adult Services, the 11

sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to fund Project C.A.R.E. (Caregiver Alternatives to Running on Empty), which provides respite care and support to families caring for a person with dementia. The goal of the program is to increase quality, access, choice, and use of respite and support services to low-income rural and minority caregivers.
