SENATE BILL 1989 RATIFIED BILL

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A SEASON FOR THE TRAPPING OF FOXES IN CRAVEN COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open season for taking foxes by trapping from January 2 through February 28 of each year.
SECTION 2. No season bag limit applies to foxes taken under this act.
SECTION 3. The North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission shall

provide for the sale of foxes taken lawfully pursuant to this act.

SECTION 4. This act applies only to Craven County.

SECTION 5. This act is effective when it becomes law.
