The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 20-175(d) reads as rewritten:	
"(d) Local governments may enact ordinances restricting or prohibiting	ng a person
from standing on any street, highway, or right-of-way excluding sidew	
soliciting, or attempting to solicit, any employment, business, or contribution	
driver or occupants of any vehicle. This subsection does not permit	
restrictions or prohibitions on the activities of licensees, employees, or con	
the Department of Transportation or of any municipality engaged in cons	
maintenance or in making traffic or engineering surveys surveys. except as	provided in
subsection (e) of this section."	
SECTION 2. G.S. 20-175(e) is repealed.	
SECTION 3. This act applies to the City of Durham only.	
SECTION 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
