SENATE BILL 2139*

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW PROHIBITING THE TAKING OF DEER FROM A
BOAT IN BERTIE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 5 of S.L. 2001-367 reads as rewritten:

"**SECTION 5.** It is unlawful to take deer from any vessel in the Roanoke River
~~above the U.S. Highway 17 bridge, or its tributaries~~ whether the vessel is under power
or not, except that a vessel may be used for transportation to and from otherwise lawful
hunting stands upon land owned or leased by a person or upon which a person has
written permission to hunt."

SECTION 2. This act applies only to Bertie County.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 2008, and applies to acts
committed on or after that date.
