1 A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE 2007 GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO
2 CONSIDER A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO MAKE THE CRIMINAL
3 OFFENSE OF SIMPLE ASSAULT A FELONY RATHER THAN A
4 MISDEMEANOR WHEN THE SIMPLE ASSAULT IS COMMITTED AGAINST
5 A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, A FIREFIGHTER, OR EMERGENCY
6 PERSONNEL.

7 Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:

8 **SECTION 1.** The 2007 General Assembly may consider "A BILL TO BE
9 ENTITLED AN ACT TO MAKE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF SIMPLE
10 ASSAULT A FELONY RATHER THAN A MISDEMEANOR WHEN THE SIMPLE
11 ASSAULT IS COMMITTED AGAINST A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, A
12 FIREFIGHTER, OR EMERGENCY PERSONNEL."

13 **SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective upon ratification.
