A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE AGRICULTURAL LEADERSHIP

DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM IN NORTH CAROLINA STATE UNIVERSITY'S

COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND LIFE SCIENCES.

16 17 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at North Carolina State University. These funds shall be used to develop the leadership skills of outstanding young agriculturists from a diversity of agricultural enterprises and regions of the State. The North Carolina State University College of Agriculture and Life Sciences Agricultural Leadership Program is a two-year program led by the faculty of the College.

SECTION 2. It is the intent of the General Assembly that funds for the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences Agricultural Leadership Program be included in the continuation budget.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
