A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW

DINING AND RECREATION HALL AT THE NORTH CAROLINA FFA

CENTER AT WHITE LAKE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina Association of Future Farmers of America, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for the construction of a new dining and recreation hall and to further develop and maintain the buildings and campus at the North Carolina FFA Center at White Lake, North Carolina. These funds must be matched on the basis of one dollar (\$1.00) of non-State funds for every one dollar (\$1.00) of State funds.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina Association of Future Farmers of America, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for expansion of the Future Farmers of America (FFA) and agriculture education in North Carolina.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
