A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE
COMMISSION ON SEAFOOD AND AQUACULTURE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 120-70.61(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) The Joint Legislative Commission on Seafood and Aquaculture shall consist of <u>15-18</u> members: four Senators appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; four Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; four members appointed by the Governor; and three members appointed by the Commissioner of <u>Agriculture.Agriculture</u>; one member designated by the Board of Directors of the North Carolina Fisheries Association; one member designated by the Board of Directors of the North Carolina Watermen United; and one member designated by the Board of Directors of the North Carolina Chapter of the Coastal Conservation <u>Association</u>. The members shall serve at the pleasure of their appointing <u>officer.officer</u> or their respective associations."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
