A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE
COMMISSION ON SEAFOOD AND AQUACULTURE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 120-70.61(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) The Joint Legislative Commission on Seafood and Aquaculture shall consist of ~~15~~19 members: four Senators appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; four Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; four members appointed by the Governor; and ~~three~~four members appointed by the Commissioner of ~~Agriculture~~Agriculture; and in addition, one member representing the recreational/sport fishing industry shall be appointed by the Governor; one member representing the charter boat/headboat industry shall be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and one member representing the commercial fishing industry shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The members shall serve at the pleasure of their appointing officer."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
