2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE BENT CREEK INSTITUTE AT THE NORTH CAROLINA ARBORETUM. 3

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Bent Creek Institute, 6 Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 7 2009-2010 fiscal year for continuation of the Institute's core activities and partnerships facilitating research and development, new enabling technologies, North America's only 8 9 medicinal herb germplasm repository, and the critical capacity for business creation and attraction in the twenty-five billion dollar (\$25,000,000,000) United States dietary supplement 10 and functional food industries. The Bent Creek Institute, located at the North Carolina 11 12 Arboretum, is leading the creation of a statewide cluster of business, jobs, and commerce centered around nutraceutical and pharmaceutical development, processing, manufacturing, and 13 global distribution. The Bent Creek Institute is recognized as a catalyst for profitable use of 14 Western North Carolina's unique biodiversity and existing workforce and has established 15 productive partnerships nationally. 16
