"(a1) A contract between a husband and wife to waive, release, or establish right obligations to postseparation support, alimony, or spousal support is valid and not incommon with public policy, with or without valuable consideration, if the contract is in writing acknowledged by both parties before a certifying officer. A release made pursuant subsection may be pleaded in bar of any action or proceeding for the recovery of the released."	nsistent and is to this
SECTION 2. G.S. 50-16.6(b) reads as rewritten:	
"(b) Alimony, postseparation support, and counsel fees may be barred by an opprovision of a valid separation agreement or premarital agreement agreement, preagreement, or marital contract made pursuant to G.S. 52-10(a1) so long as the agree performed."	marita
