SE	ECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Depart	ment of
Health and Human Services the sum of one million one hundred seventy-eight thousand dollars		
(\$1,178,000)	for the 2009-2010 fiscal year and the sum of one million one l	nundred
seventy-eight thousand dollars (\$1,178,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year for parenting		
programs that prevent pregnant and parenting students from dropping out of school. These		
funds shall be used to accomplish each of the following:		
(1)	Increase individual local grants from forty-seven thousand nine l	nundred
	eighty dollars (\$47,980) to sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000).
