7	SECTION 1. G.S. 90B-3(8) reads as rewritten:		
8	"The following definitions apply in this Chapter:

10	(8) Social Worker. – A person engaging in the practice of social work w	ho is	
11	not certified or licensed under this Chapter as a Certified Social We	rker,	
12	Certified Master Social Worker, Licensed Clinical Social Worke	r , or	
13	Certified Social Work Manager.certified, licensed, or provisionally lice	nsed	
14	by this Chapter or otherwise exempt under G.S. 90B-10."		
15	SECTION 2. G.S. 90B-10 is amended by adding the following new subsection	on to	
16	read:		
17	"(c) Notwithstanding the requirements of G.S. 90B-16, any individual who is empl	oyed	
18	by an agency of a local or State governmental entity, and who is in a position holding the	title	
19	of 'Social Worker' or any variation of the name, and whose position title is derived from		
20	Office of State Personnel Social Work Series may use the title 'Social Worker' or any vari	ation	
21	of the title."		
22	SECTION 3. Chapter 90B of the General Statutes is amended by adding	g the	
23	following new section to read:		
24	" <u>§ 90B-16. Title protection.</u>		
25	(a) Except as provided in G.S. 90B-10, an individual who (i) is not certified, lice		
26	or provisionally licensed by this Chapter as a social worker, (ii) does not hold a bachelo		
27	master's degree in social work from a college or university having a social work pro	-	
28	accredited or admitted to candidacy for accreditation by the Council of Social Work Education		
29	or (iii) has not received a doctorate in social work, shall not use the title 'Social Worker' o	r any	
30	variation of the title.		
31	(b) The Board is authorized to enforce title protection pursuant to this section	<u>n in</u>	
32	accordance with G.S. 90B-13.		
33	(c) <u>The Board shall adopt rules to implement this section.</u> "		
34	SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
